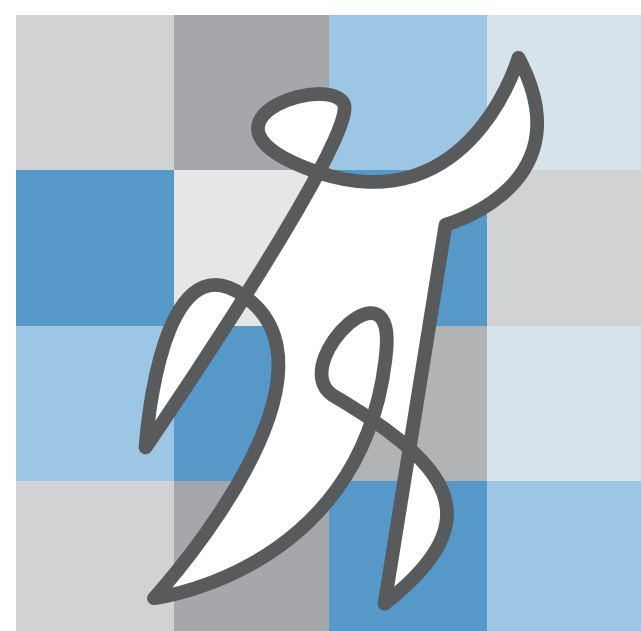


First combined PET/CT scanner in Northern California
